 - Restricted Stock Units (RSUs), convert into shares of common stock on a one-for-one basis. These RSUs are issued pursuant to a provision under the issuer's Management Stock Purchase Plan (MSPP) pursuant to which certain executives may make an advance
- election to receive RSUs in lieu of a specified percentage or dollar amount of an individual's annual incentive cash bonus under bonus plan applicable to the executive. The RSUs are issued in whole units on the basis of a 33% discount from the fair market value of the issuer's common stock on the date the underlying bonus is determined and generally vest 3 years from the date of the grant, at which time they convert into shares of common stock unless the executive has previously selected a longer deferral period.
